Dear Sir: - Will you please answer in writing the following questions.

1. Is it practicable to incorporate a general church-body, Synod or association, with rights to exercise jurisdiction all over the United States, and for religious, educational, and charitable purposes under the statutes of Nebraska?
2. If so, can such a body incorporate hold its annual meeting for election of trustees and other officers, and for transaction of its general business, outside of the state?
3. And will it be lawful to elect ^{for trustees} any number outside of the state, or shall a certain number be elected in state or county of main place of business?

4. If general church-body is not incorporated, but a separate institution, such as Trinity Seminary, can ownership and full control over such institution then be secured for such general body by making trustees of such institution dependent on rules and regulations laid down by such general body?
5. And can such gen. body, in that last case, hold the right to elect the trustees of such institution at the annual meeting of such body? And, further, does law require a certain number of trustees to reside in county, where institution is located?
6. How proceed to incorporate in either case?
7. Does expiration of articles of incorporation interfere with the rights of an institution, when continued in operation? And how can property now belonging to Trinity Seminary be legally transferred to some other incorporation? Respectfully
